



When it became known that Pastor Erik would not continue as our pastor beyond June 30, 2022, the bishop and district superintendent prayerfully began seeking a new pastor for Avery, and ultimately discerned Pastor Bill as a good fit for this church's membership and ministry.

DISTRICT AND CONFERENCE NEWS

Avery UMC is part of the Washington District within the Western PA Conference of the United Methodist Church.

The 2022 Western Pennsylvania Annual Conference Session will occur June 2-4 at Erie Bayfront Convention Center. This year's Lay Delegate is Dana Stainbrook (J.R. Pond was elected but is no longer able to attend). Annual Conference includes an ordination service, a memorial service, bible study, reports, and legislation voted on by delegates. Every year the legislation covers the Annual Conference budget, approvals of several nominating reports and proposed celebrations, and matters of pastoral compensation and benefits. This year's legislation also includes proposals for how to allow churches to leave the denomination if they desire. You may follow along via live stream at WPAUMC.org.
